MILITARY COMMITTEE SEEKS INITIATIVE IN CONSTITUTION DEADLOCK

THE Military Committee has been keeping busy these last few months as the Government struggles to agree on a new constitution. The current constitution is still suspended because of the state of emergency that was enacted during the Civil War. While it was agreed that a new constitution should be written, the consensus on the actual articles is yet to be reached leaving the nation without a constitution and a proper government. The Military Committee however has been hard at work trying to bring some normality to the Imperial Grand Duchy. Recently the Military Tribunals of the traitors that joined the rebels in the Civil War took place in the capital, New Charter. Lieutenant Benjamin Ortiz, Private Susan Ryder and Private Gus Nevin were all dishonourably discharged from the military and branded traitors for their individual

roles throughout the Civil War. Benjamin Ortiz was found guilty of assisting an enemy, misconduct on operations, mutiny and desertion while Ryder and Nevin were found guilty of assisting an enemy and desertion.

The Revolutionary Armed Forces of Colombia (FARC) was also removed from the list of banned terrorist groups, organisations and associations. Following a peace deal with the Colombian government, the FARC has began taking sufficient steps to disarm themselves.
